

**RUSSELL COUNTY FISCAL COURT
CALLED MEETING
FRIDAY FEBRUARY 20, 2023
10:00 A.M.**


The Russell County Fiscal Court held a called meeting on Monday February 20, 2023 at 10:00 a.m. at the Russell County Courthouse. Those in attendance were County Judge Executive Randy Marcum, Magistrates Mickey Garner, Zach Wilson, Steve Richardson, Larry Skaggs, County Attorney Kevin Shearer and County Treasurer Kim Blanchet. Magistrate Waddell was absent from the meeting.

PAY BILLS: Judge Marcum submitted a list of bills to be approved. Magistrate Richardson made a motion to pay the bills with Magistrate Skaggs seconding. All were in favor none opposed. Motion passed.

1ST READING AMENDED ORDINANCE 19-01: Judge Marcum asked County Attorney Shearer to explain. County Attorney Shearer stated ordinance 19-01 maintained its original verbiage with the following exceptions. He stated Section 3 had been amended to measure the occupational license tax at 1% and in Section 4 the Alternative Tax would be capped at \$4,000.00. He also stated Section 16 which was the Sunset Clause had been eliminated.

OPIOID SETTLEMENT – JAMESTOWN: Judge Marcum stated he had been informed by former Judge Executive Robertson that he had committed to give 15% of the counties Opioid Settlement Money to the City of Russell Springs and 10% to the City of Jamestown. He went on to state the City of Russell Springs actually received a portion of the Opioid Settlement funds but the City of Jamestown did not and he would like to honor the commitment to give 10% to the City of Jamestown. Magistrate Garner made a motion to give 10% of the Opioid Settlement funds to the City of Jamestown with Magistrate Wilson seconding. All were in favor none opposed. Motion passed.

ADJOURN: Magistrate Skaggs made a motion to adjourn with Magistrate Garner seconding. All was in favor. The meeting adjourned at 10:04 a.m.
